Member & New guest introductions

MOTION: Minutes from October 12, 2021 meeting approved as presented - accepted by Dianne; 2nd Chris

Treasurer's Report - Dianne Larsen

- Balance: \$24,091
- Revenue: \$233,914, \$1,358 Bar D, \$32,000 groomer sale, \$528 memberships and swag, \$200,000 groomer grant, \$28 insurance refund
- Expenses: \$209,823, \$538 loan fees, \$209,261 groomer purchase, \$24 checks
- Barlow: \$40,088, includes \$34,635 CPW grant. Account to be closed as soon as the Barlow parking project is completed later this year.
- TBK Bank Loan: \$30k loan, 5 year term @ 4.25%, \$6,750 yearly payment, no pre-payment penalties
- BRP Grant: \$5,000 Curt filled out grant and we were selected
- MOTION: Accept Treasurer's report as presented accepted by Dave; 2nd Ken

- Discussion about clearing/cleaning up trails so that it will be easier to groom this winter
- Keep track of volunteer hours that are accrued doing tasks and turn them in
- There will be grooming training on the new groomer when it snows
- Grooming Clinic at Piston Bully on Saturday, November 13

Membership - 107 Members

<u>Old/Unfinished Business</u> –

Beaver Meadows

- Beaver Meadows has 7 more years of logging
- Brian is going to meet with loggers and see if we can have from Jan 1 through the middle of March
- One contractor has to log through the winter
- Ken will contact Pagosa Snowmobile club and see if they are going to groom this year
- Forest Service going for a grant in 2023 for parking lot at the head of Beaver Meadows
- If someone wants to plow Curt will get a permit from Forest Service but you will not get paid

Barlow Parking Area

- CDOT is going to go in and level it
- CDOT will look at it the end of this week

Purgatory Parking Area

• If you made a comment last year you have 20 days to make the objection

• Parking lot has to be completed by the end of 2025 per the Restoration, Mitigation, and Monitoring required in the 2008 ROD document **Echo Basin**—Loggers pulling out of Echo Basin for the winter

SJS swag-Dianne has SJS shirts, stickers, and radios, Dianne is going to check into ordering new SJS swag items

New Groomer

- Dianne is going to contact our insurance company and see if we supply groomer manual that we can get a break on our insurance
